- Although signatures are not required, a check for obligations will be done at the time of ticket purchase. Please ensure you have no financial or library obligations.
- As this is a school event, all Chapter 19 policies will be enforced.
- Guests may not be older than 20 years old. Dance attendees still in school must be in high school **and** at least 14 years old.
- Refunds will not be given. For any reason. Trading or selling of tickets are not allowed. Tickets are non-transferable.

- All attendees are required to submit this form with all appropriate signatures and abide by all school rules and the terms contained in this agreement. Anyone exhibiting disruptive behavior will be removed from the dance, parents will be notified, and refunds will be given.
- Students may be checked for illegal or controlled substances prior to entry to the dance area. Students will be required to check large bags at the door. Administrators, security officers and chaperones will determine what size bags should be checked.
- Parents, family members or others adults are asked not to rent hotel rooms for unaccompanied students.
- All students and guests must present their student ID or government issued ID at the registration table. Guests must arrive to the dance with their Kealakehe sponsoring student.
